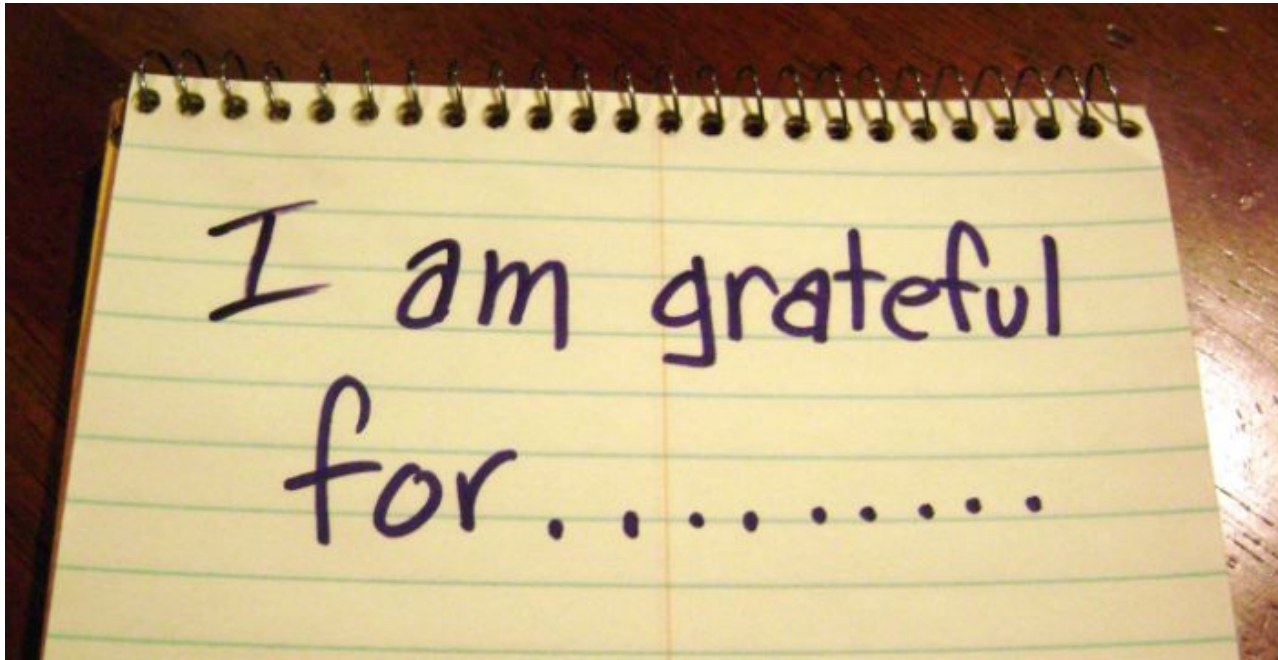

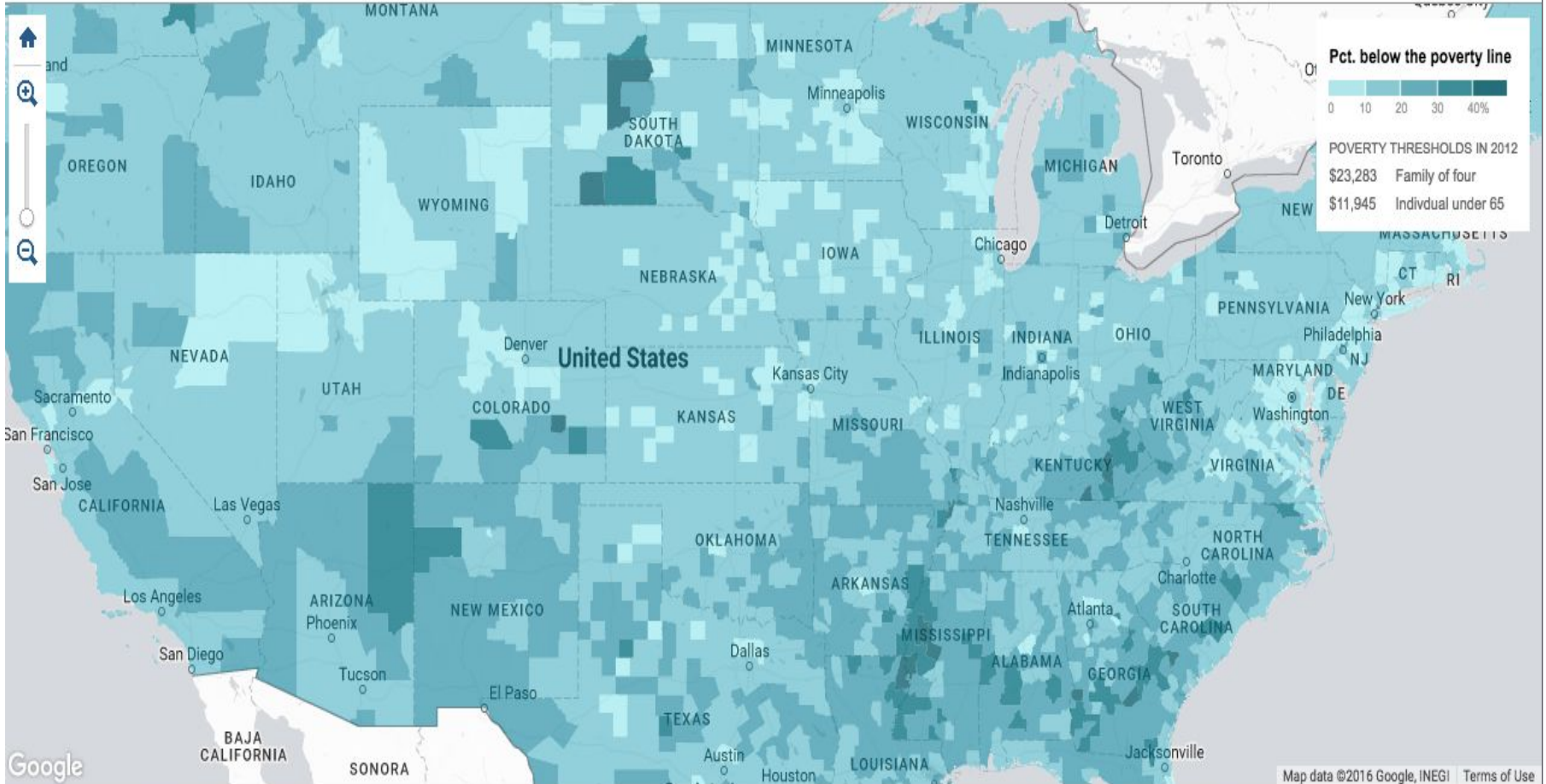

VIEW Percentage below the poverty line Number living in poverty



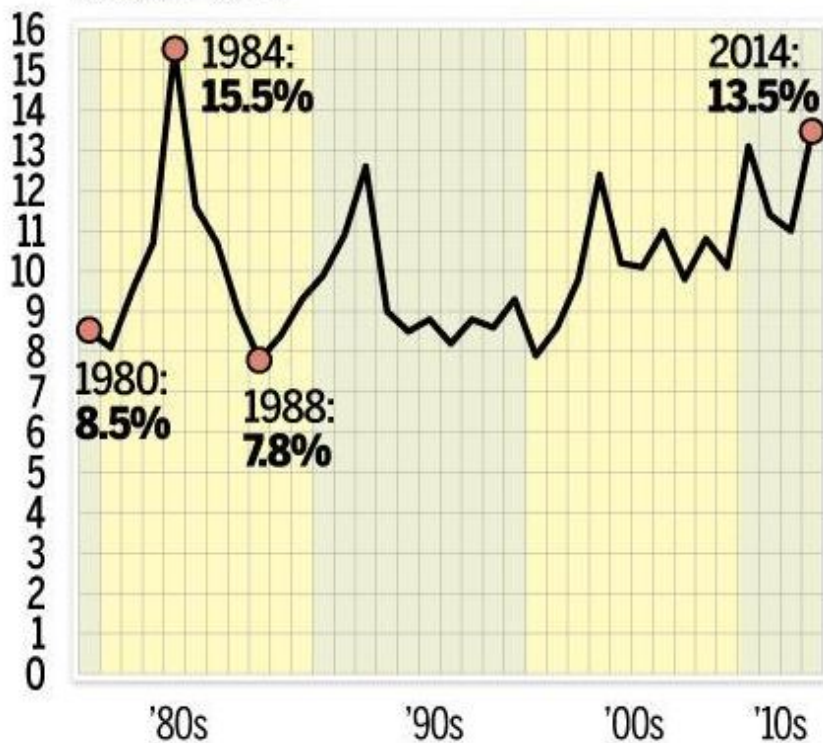

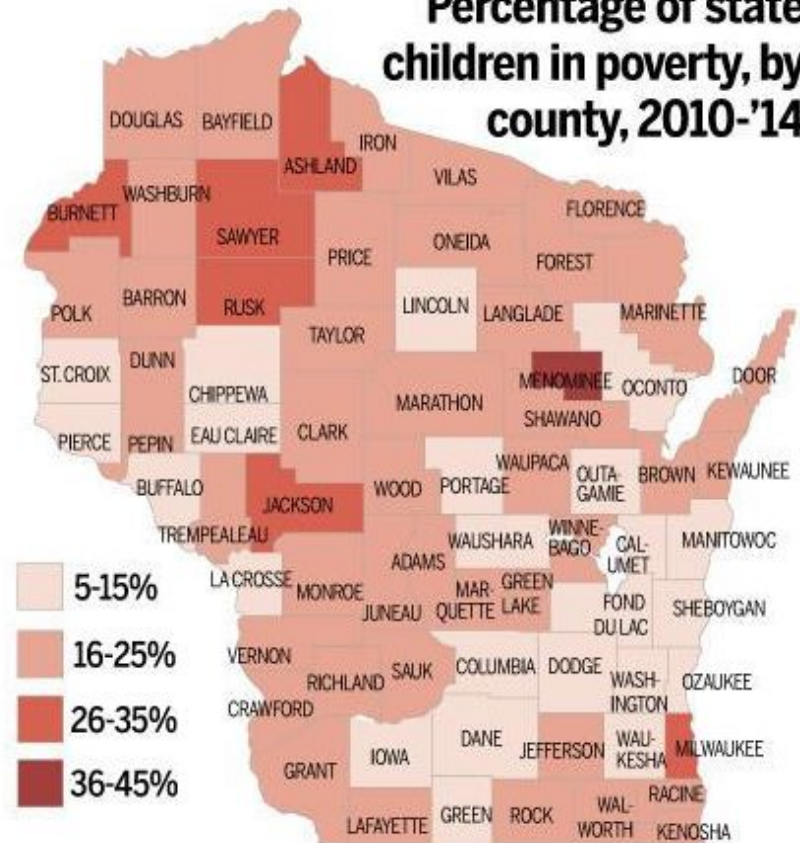
Poverty hits 30- year high

Percentage of state in poverty, 1980-2014



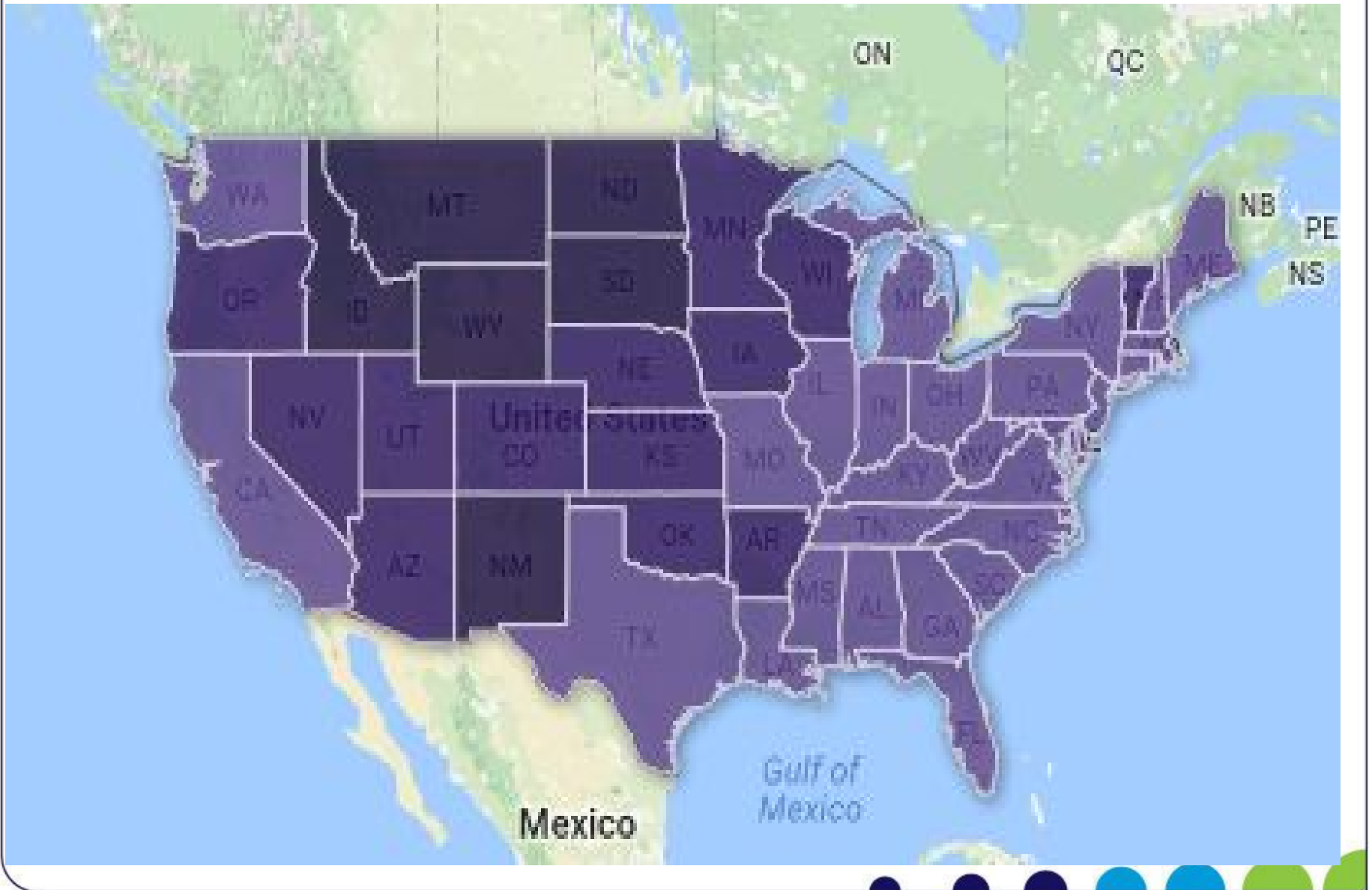
Percentage of state children in poverty, by county, 2010-'14

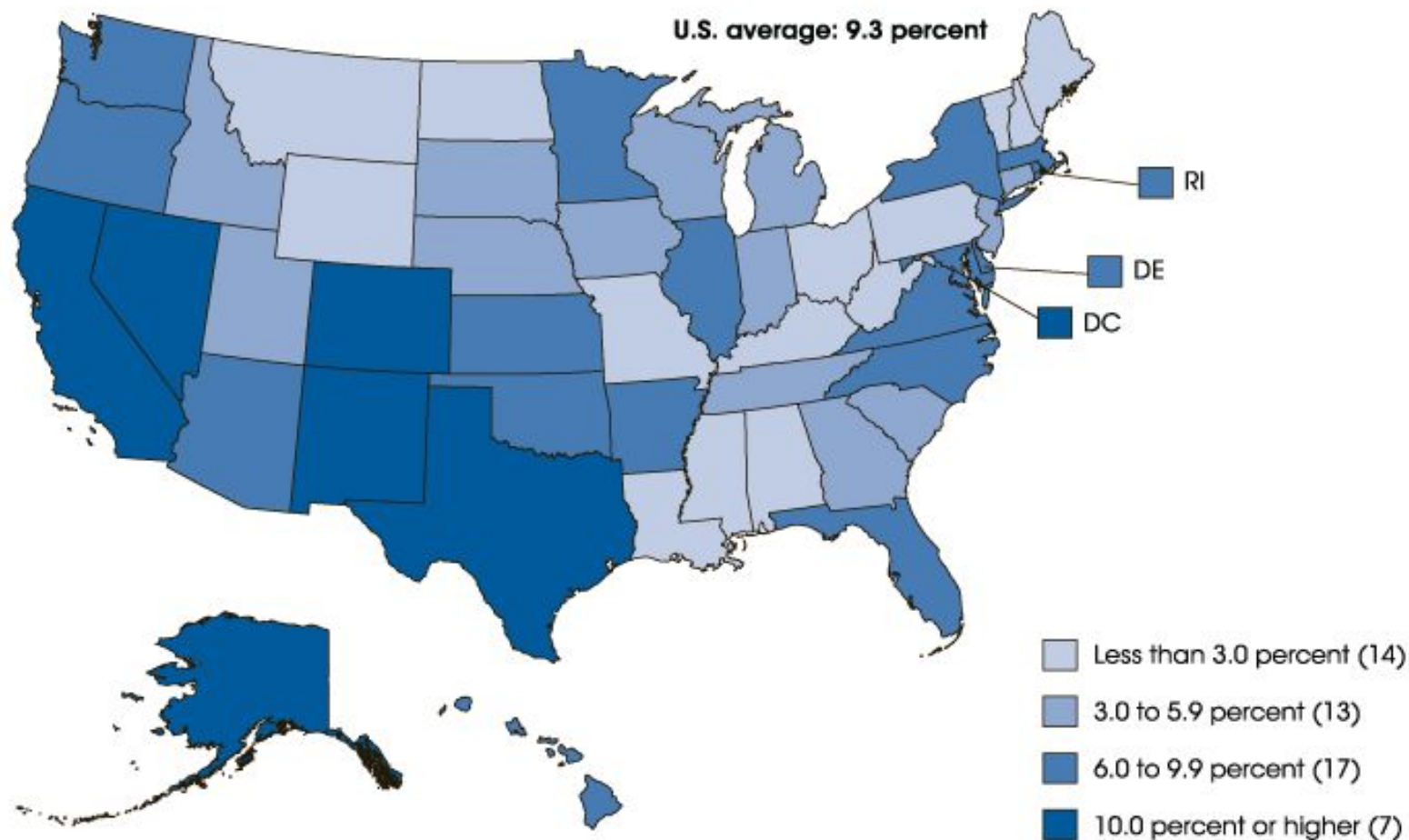

Figure 1. Percentage of public school students who were English language learners, by state: School year 2013–14

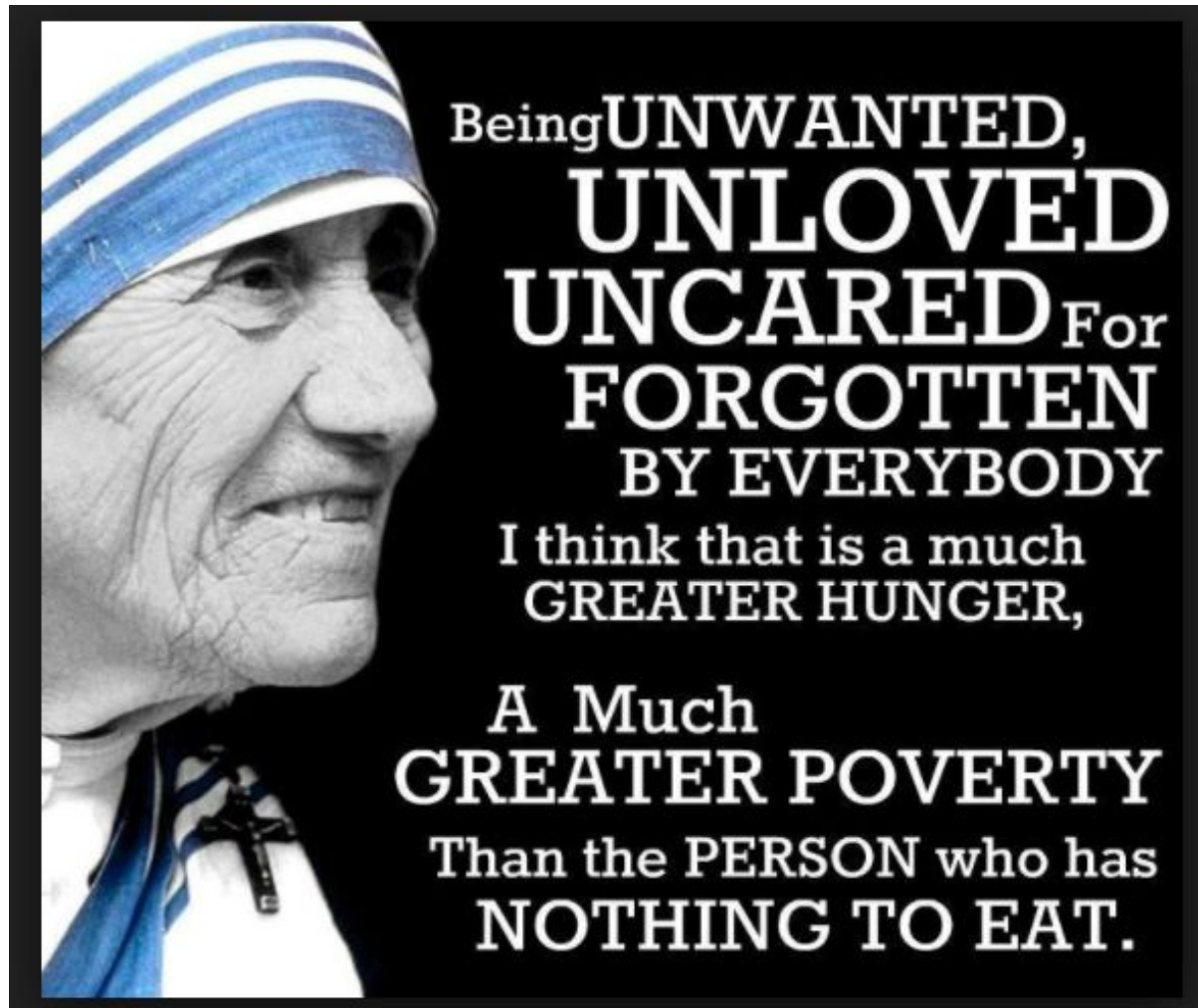

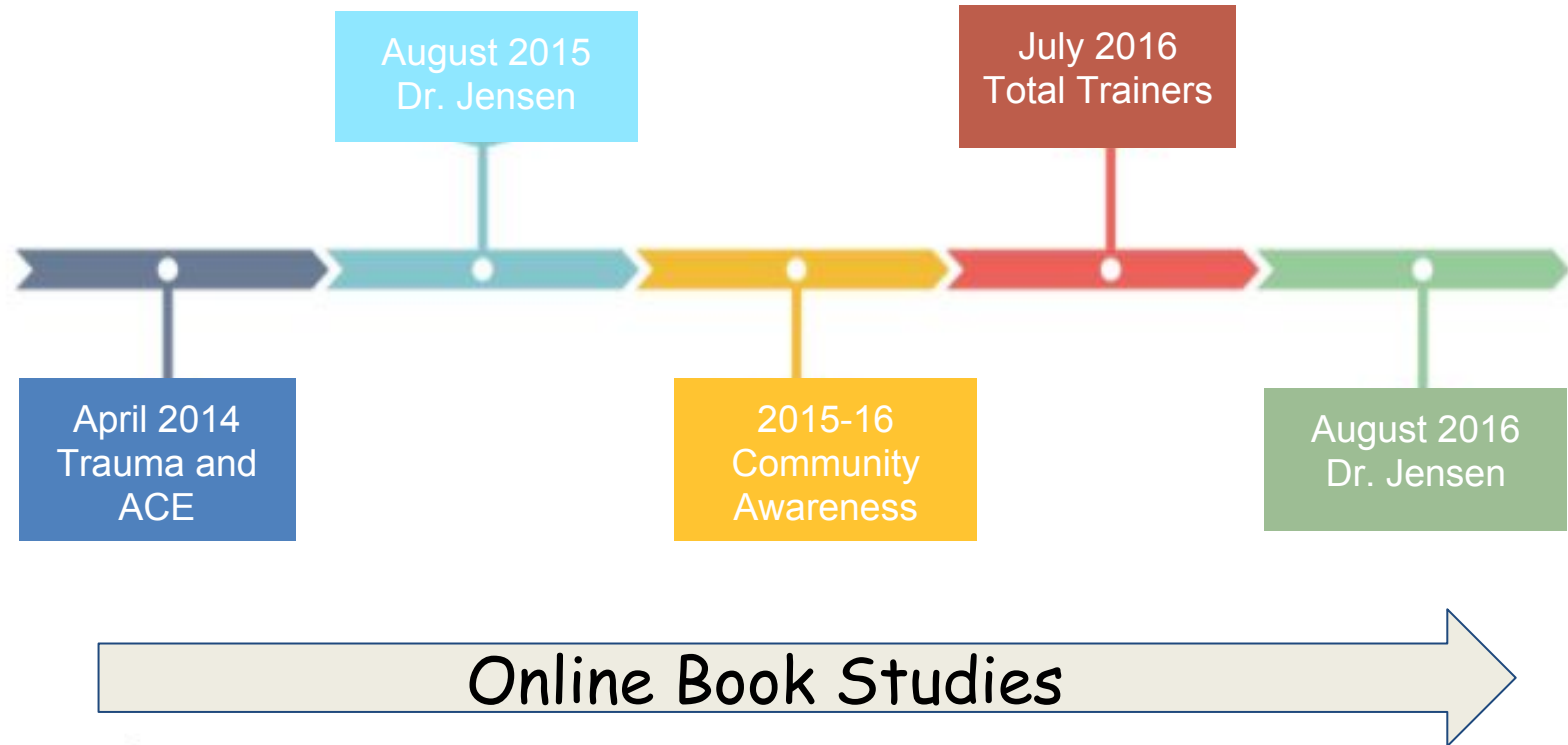

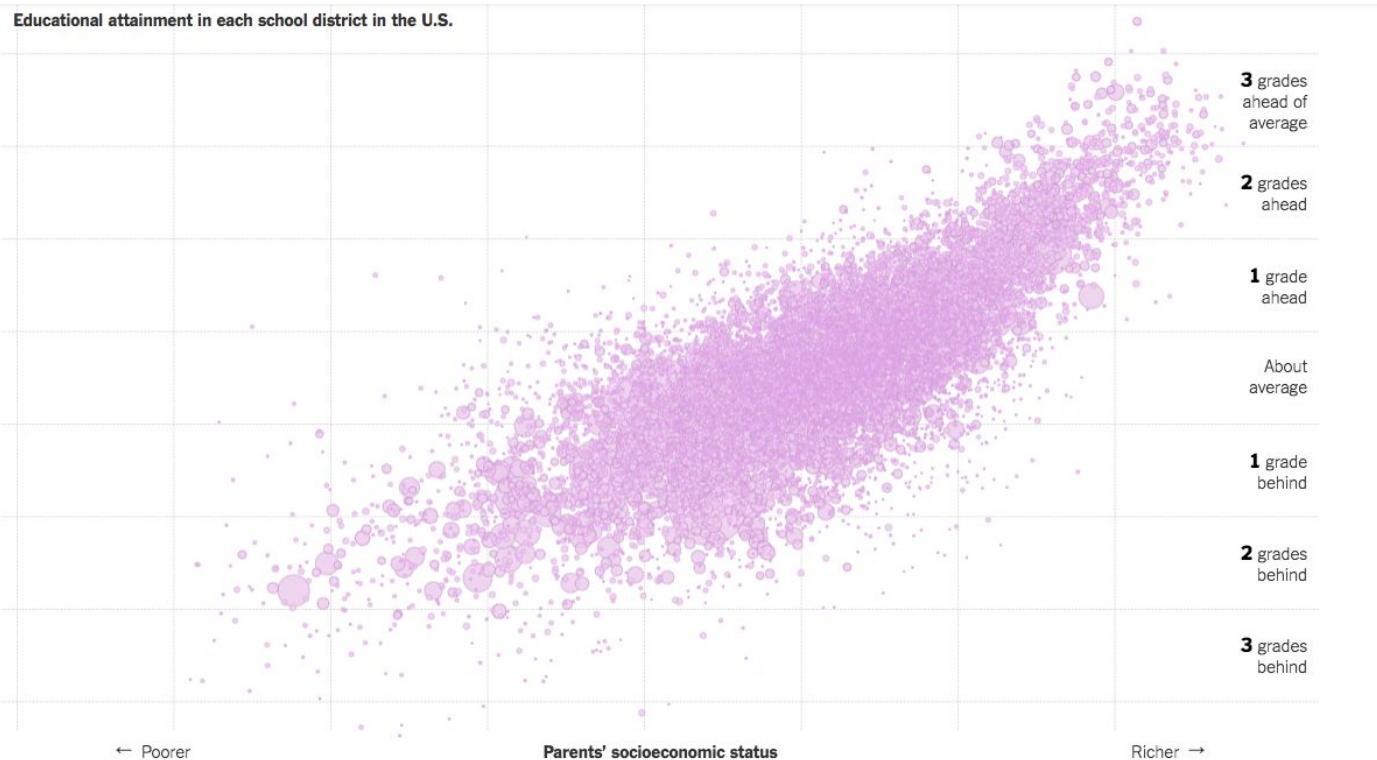
