At a screening distance of 10 feet, EyeSpy 20/20 adheres with social distancing guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, can screen hundreds of students on a single computer every month and requires NO time manually recording results, creating referral letters for parents & guardians, or producing summary reports.

Unlike traditional, en masse vision screenings utilizing the wall chart, EyeSpy 20/20 facilitates vision screenings without the need for certified screening personnel, laborious recording keeping / reporting, while maintaining proper social distancing and allowing all screenings to be completed early in the school year. The unique game-like experience makes the vision screening process fun for students and screeners alike.

For orders placed before December 31, 2020, the cost for the first year has been reduced to \$200 per campus when a 3-year agreement is executed. The cost for subsequent years is \$5 per screened student (no cost to re-screen students) plus optional vision screening kits (\$75 / kit).

Each campus receives:

- One vision screening kit containing [a] reversible occluders, [b] stereopsis testing glasses, [c] 10-foot mouse extension cable, [d] eye patch, [e] HOTV response panel, [f] near stereo testing card, and [g] quick start guide.
- Unlimited use of EyeSpy 20/20 vision screening software through June 30, 2021, enabling each campus to screen as many students as desired, including those not required in state or school district vision screening guidelines.
- Secure 24/7 access to the HIPAA/FERPA-compliant data collection, storage and bilingual reporting system.
- Unlimited access to recorded training videos, electronic user manuals, and email technical support.
- Parents & guardians of “off-campus” students, may screen their student’s vision using the mobile EyeSpy 20/20 application. Mobile app results are manually reported to the school by the parent or guardian.

Screening logistics:

- Person(s) responsible for screening vision views a 15-minute training video online to familiarize themselves with the process of screening vision using the EyeSpy 20/20 program. This is the only training necessary and is accessible anytime on our website.
- Before and after screening each student, clean and sanitize all contact surfaces including the desk, chair, computer mouse, glasses, occluders, etc. with appropriate disinfectant.
- While wearing gloves, the screener presses a key to start the game. During the screening process, the EyeSpy 20/20 program displays on-screen instructions. The vision screener can explain the instructions to students who need assistance.
- Immediately following the automated screening, results are shown on-screen, stored in a secure database and can be subsequently accessed and / or printed in English or Spanish at any time.
